NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF KENT

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
(PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY SR96 AT KEMSING AND PUBLIC BRIDLEWAY MR227 AT
WROTHAM) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2020**

On 3rd September 2020 the Kent County Council confirmed the above Order without modifications.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by **(a)** upgrading the length of Public Footpath SR96 to Bridleway status (and will retain its identification of SR96) with a width of 2.8 metres, which commences at its junction with Public Highway D204 at NGR TQ 5723 5885 (Point A on the order plan) and follows an established track which runs in an easterly direction for 654 metres to NGR TQ 5787 5886 (Point B). As shown by the bold black dashed line with vertical lines in the gaps between Points A and B on the order plan.

And **(b)** upgrading a length of Public Footpath MR227 to Bridleway status (and will retain its identification of MR227) with a width of 2.8 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5787 5886 (Point B) and follows an established track, which runs in an easterly direction for 366 metres to its junction with the Public Highway C261 at NGR TQ 5823 5886 (Point C). As shown by the bold black dashed line with vertical lines in the gaps between Points B and C on the order plan.

All distances are approximate, all directions are general.

This Order became operative as from the 3rd September 2020 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 to the Act have not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he may, under Paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to the Act, within 42 days from 11th September 2020 make application for the purpose to the High Court.

This Order is made by the Kent County Council ("the Authority") under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Secretary of State (who has directed the Authority to that effect) that map sheet 021 (TQ55NE) of the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Kent requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c) (ii) namely the discovery of evidence by the Authority which shows that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description (section 53(3)(c)(ii));

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.


The Kent County Council hereby orders that:

2. Sheet 021 (TQ55NE) of the Definitive Map for the County of Kent and its associated Statement shall be modified as described in Part I of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "*The Kent County Council (Public Bridleway SR96 at Kemsing and Public Bridleway MR227 at Wrotham) Definitive Map Modification Order 2020*"

PART I: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

Description of paths to be modified

The effect of the Order is to modify (a) the length of Public Footpath SR96 to Bridleway status (and will retain its identification of SR96) with a width of 2.8 metres, which commences at its junction with Public Highway D204 at NGR TQ 5723 5885 (Point A on the order plan) and follows an established track which runs in a generally easterly direction for approximately 654 metres to NGR TQ 5787 5886 (Point B). As shown by the bold black dashed line with vertical lines in the gaps between Points A and B on the order plan.

and to modify (b) a length of Public Footpath MR227 to Bridleway status (and will retain its identification of MR227) with a width of 2.8 metres, which commences at NGR TQ 5787 5886 (Point B) and follows an established track, which runs in a generally easterly direction for approximately 366 metres to its junction with the Public Highway C261 at NGR TQ 5823 5886 (Point C). As shown by the bold black dashed line with vertical lines in the gaps between Points B and C on the order plan.

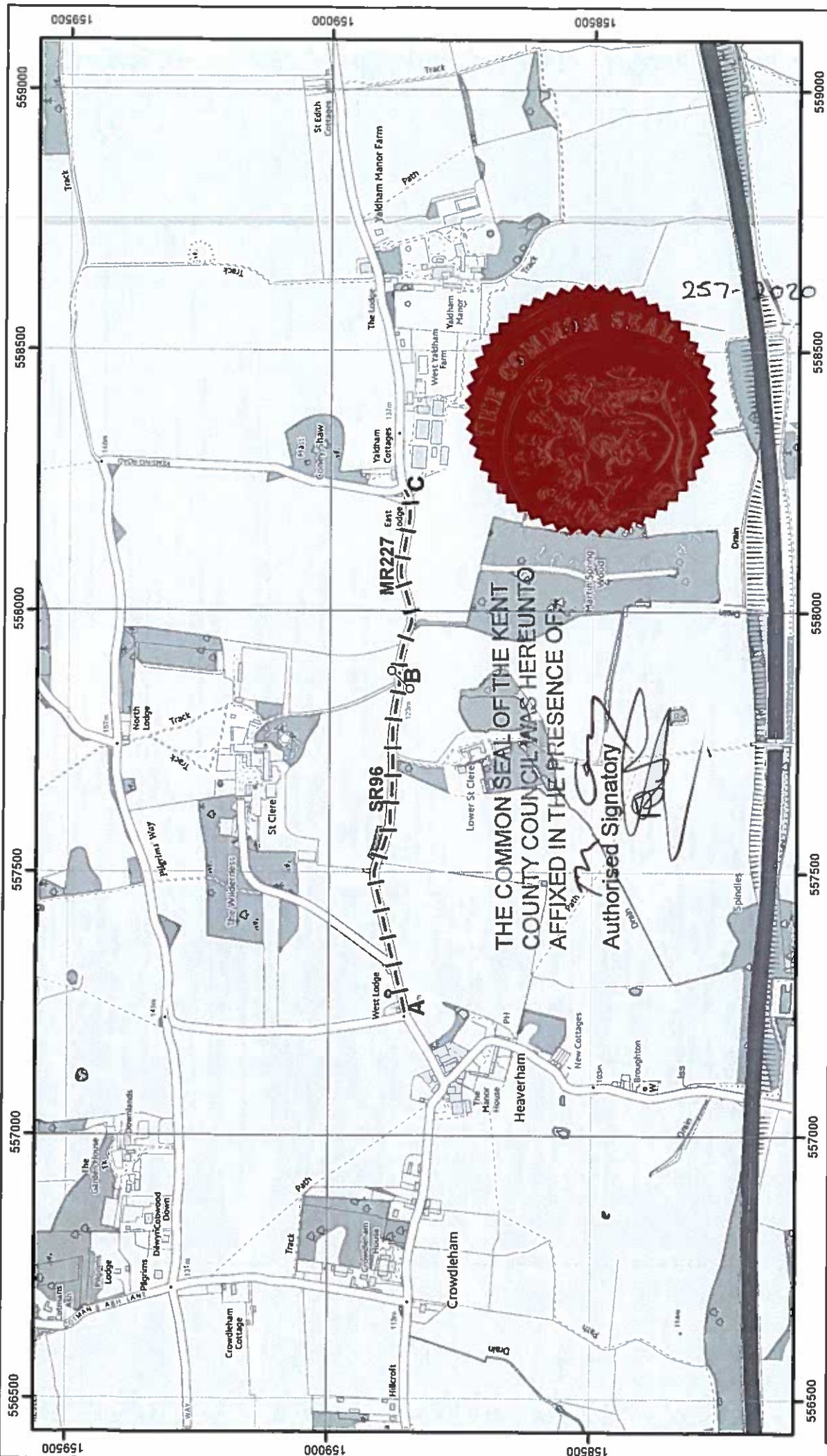
