#### **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 32, 35, 36, 45, 46, 47, 49, 53 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act'), the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the above named Order:-

Due to a new road and layout the effect of the made named Order will be to introduce waiting restrictions DYL means no waiting at any time on the following length of road in Tonbridge:-

**ANNISON STREET – DYL** (1) On the western side from its junction with Lansdown Road to a point 5 metres northeast of its junction with Bradley Street. (2) On the eastern side from its junction with Lansdown Road to a point 13 metres northeast of its junction with Bradley Street.

The Order was made on 17 September 2020 and its provisions will come into effect on 21 September 2020.

A copy of the Order, statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a map indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any Orders which will be amended by the Order may be examined on Monday to Friday at The Kent County Council, Sessions House, Maidstone, ME14 1XQ; The Kent County Council, Highway, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD during normal office hours or viewed online at [www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations](http://www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations)

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.
