And to reduce two roads to 30MPH.

In addition, the various restrictions are to:-

- Avoid the danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising

WILDWOOD ROAD and WOODSIDE ROAD – For their entire length. **BABS OAK HILL** - From its junction with Island Road to its junction with Hoades Wood Road. **HAWE LANE** – From its junction with Popes Lane to a point 102 metres east of its junction with Ladywood Road.

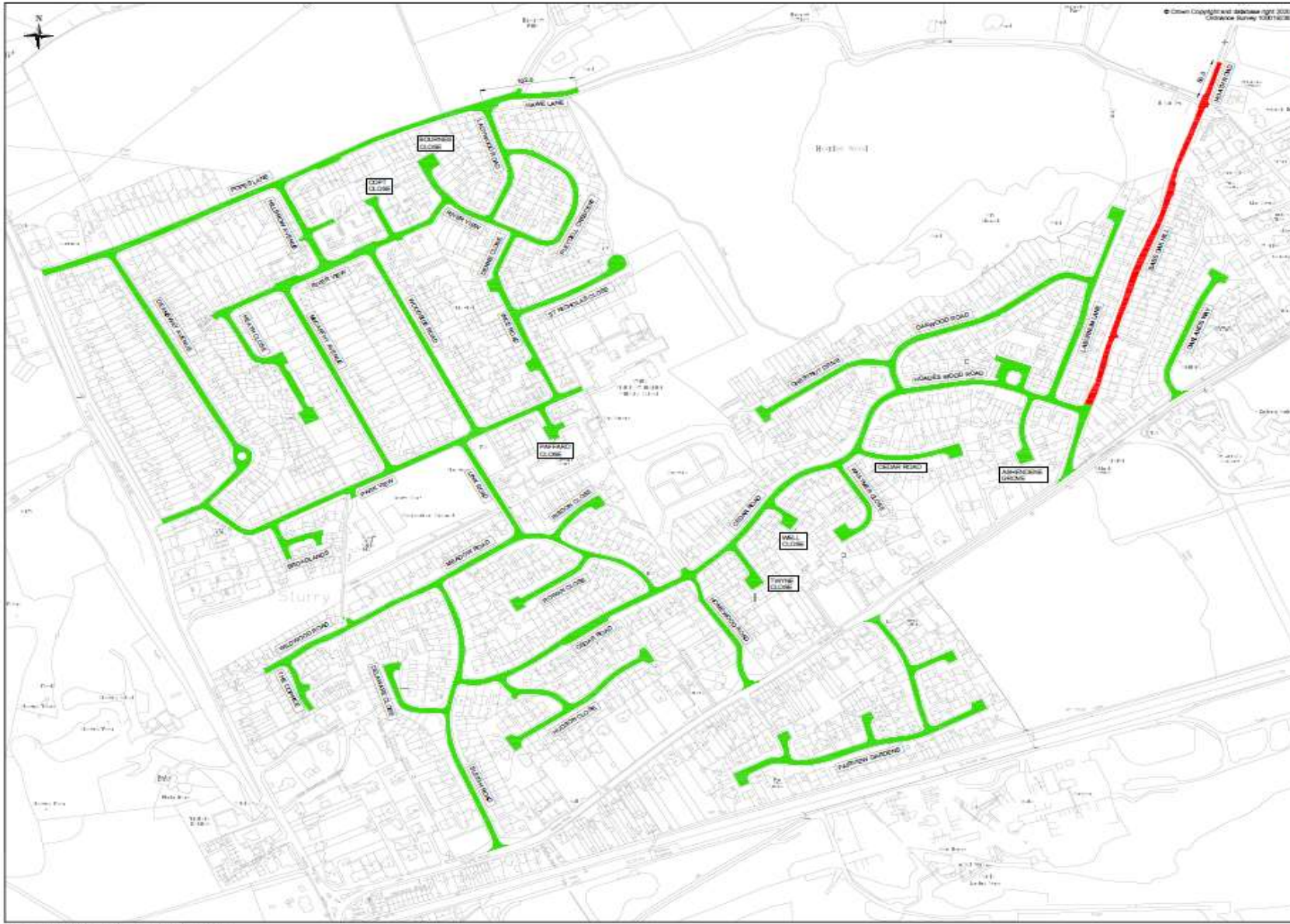
To reduce the speed limit to 30MPH on the following lengths of roads in Sturry, Canterbury;
