THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, FOLKESTONE & HYTHE) (SPEED LIMITS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2020 (AMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 2020

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council hereby make the Order under Sections 81, 82, 83 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to reduce the speed limit to 40mph in Court at Street, Lympe on the following lengths of roads:-

ALDINGTON ROAD – From a point 15 metres east of its junction with Upper Park Farm Access Road to a point 60 metres east of the eastern boundary of Ashden Lodge.
HARRINGE LANE – From its junction with Aldington Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction.

The Order was made on 7 January 2021 and its provisions will come into effect on 11 January 2021.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the proposed Order may be examined at Kent Highways, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD by appointment booked through tro@kent.gov.uk or viewed online from 8 January 2021 at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.
