We have been informed that Network Rail have appealed the rejection of their application to build a footbridge across the railway in Otford Kent

This has been opposed in the village and Kent County Council unanimously rejected the last appeal I live right next to the station and can't see any need for another bridge.

The crossing has been in use since 1862 and there has never been a fatality or a serious accident

It is clearly marked and the station and trains are clearly visible from the crossing

There are other ways of crossing the railway already available

The proposed bridge would actually be a hinderance for anyone with mobility problems and parents with children or using pushchairs

I hope you will reject this appeal
