Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as the Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ('the Act') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Office of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following order:-

The effect of the made named Order will change the speed limit to 20MPH on the following length of roads in Hawkenbury, Tunbridge Wells:-

HAWKENBURY ROAD – From the junction with Maryland Road to the western property boundary of Hawkenbury Farm.

The Order was made on 11 February 2021 and its provisions will come into effect on 15 February 2021.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the made Order may be examined at Kent Highways, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD by appointment booked through tro@kent.gov.uk or viewed online from 12 February 2021 at www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

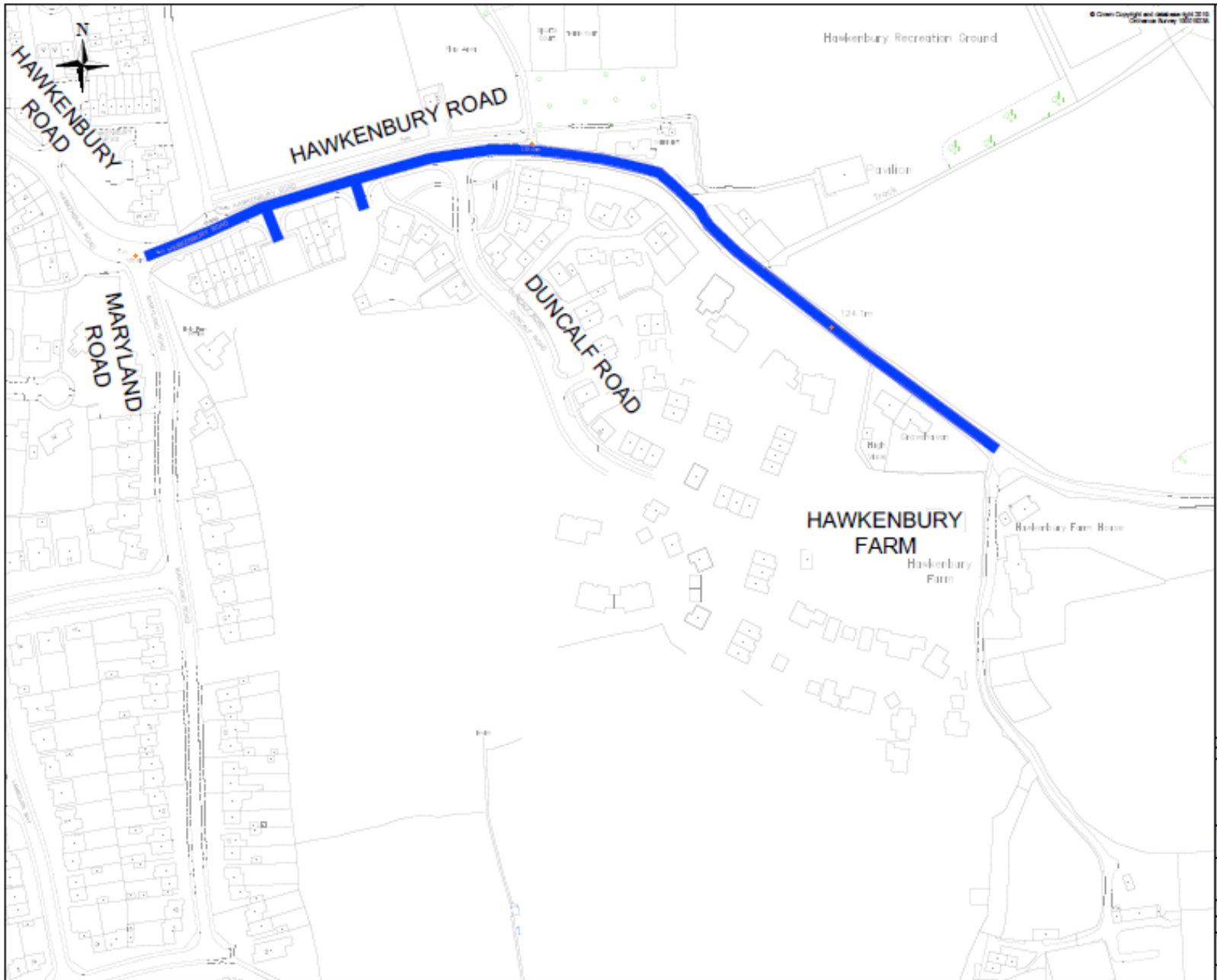
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
