# PUBLIC NOTICE



## THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, MAIDSTONE) (SPEED LIMITS) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER2020 (AMENDMENT NO.3) ORDER 2021

NOTICE is hereby given that the Kent County Council has made an Order under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to reduce the national speed limit and to extend the 30MPH speed limit in Maidstone on the following length of road:-

**HEADCORN ROAD, LENHAM** – To extend the 30MPH speed limit from a point 68 metres south west of its junction with Station Approach for a distance of 126 metres in a south westerly direction.

The Order was made on 8 April 2021 and its provisions will come into effect on 9 April 2021.

A full statement of the Council's reasons for making the Order, a plan indicating the location and the effect and a copy of any other Orders which will be amended by the made Order may be examined at Kent Highways, Transportation & Waste, Ashford Highway Depot, Henwood Industrial Estate, Unit 4 Javelin Way, Ashford, Kent TN24 8AD by appointment booked through [tro@kent.gov.uk](mailto:tro@kent.gov.uk) or viewed online from 9 April 2021 at [www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations](http://www.kent.gov.uk/highwaysconsultations)

Anyone may, by application to the High Court within 6 weeks of the date of publication of this Notice, challenge the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or any instrument made thereunder, or that there has been a failure to comply with any statutory requirement to the Orders.

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, acting as Local Traffic Authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on 9th April 2021 and may be cited as 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Maidstone) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2020 (Amendment No.3) Order 2021' ('this Order').
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, 'The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Maidstone) (Speed Limits) (Consolidation) Order 2020' ('the Order of 2020') shall have effect as though:

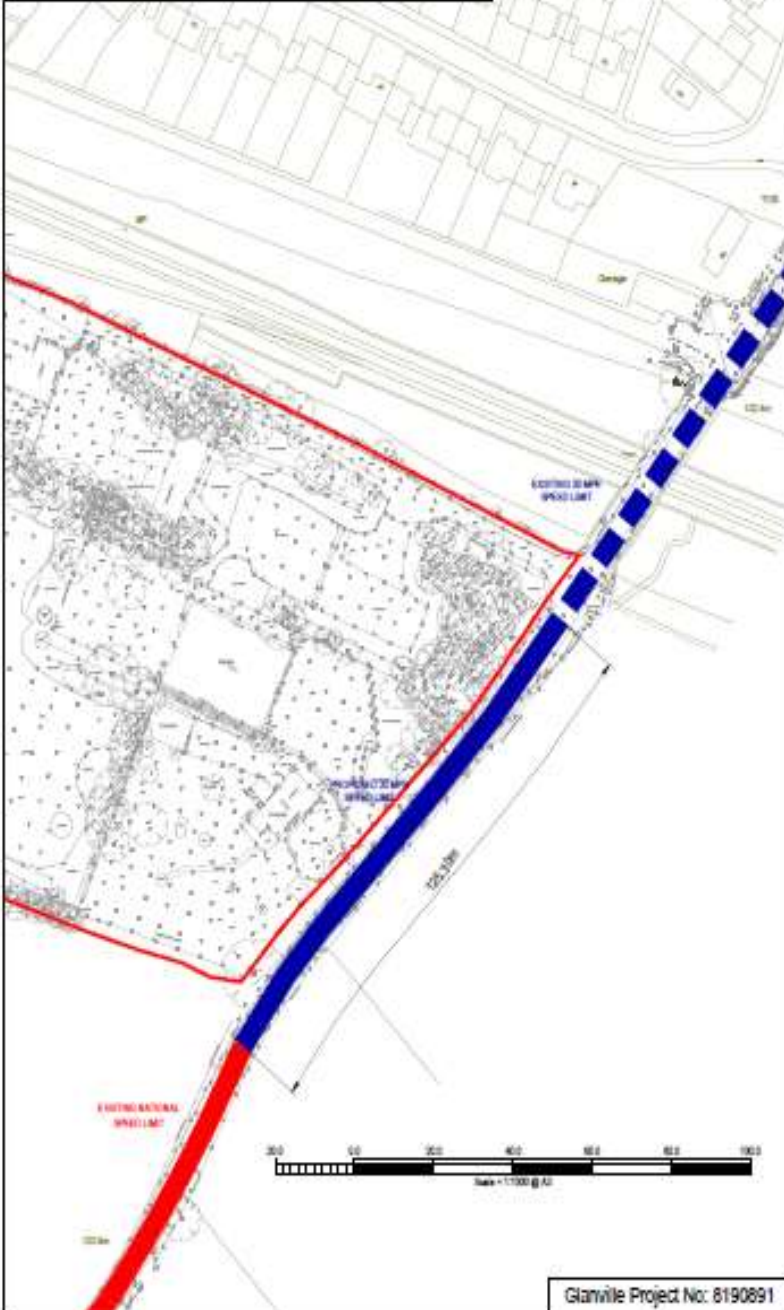
