

## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

### WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Kent County Council (Footpath EE487 at Goodnestone) Definitive Map Modification Order 2018

proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following:-

- Delete the sections of the route shown by red hatching on the Order Map and replace them with the sections represented by red dashed lines.
- Amend the key to the Order Map in light of the above modifications.

A copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 23 December 2019 have been deposited at Kent County Council, PROW & Access Service, Invicta House, County Hall, Maidstone, Kent, ME14 1XX. This Order is made by the Kent County Council ("the Authority") under section 53(2)(a) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Authority that map sheet 165 (TR25SE) of the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Kent requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i), namely the discovery of evidence by the Authority which shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path or a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a Byway Open to All Traffic.

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates.

The Kent County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is First day of May 2018.
2. Sheet 165 (TR25SE) of the Definitive Map for the County of Kent and its associated Statement shall be modified as described in Part I AND Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "The Kent County Council (Footpath EE487 at Goodnestone) Definitive Map Modification Order 2018".

### **PART I: MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP**

The effect of the Order is to add a public footpath numbered EE487 with a width of 1.5 metres, which commences on Thornton Road at NGR TR 2737 5276 and runs generally north-east for approximately 962 metres to its connection with Knowlton Lane at NGR TR 2796 5351.

Connections – Thornton Road, Knowlton Lane

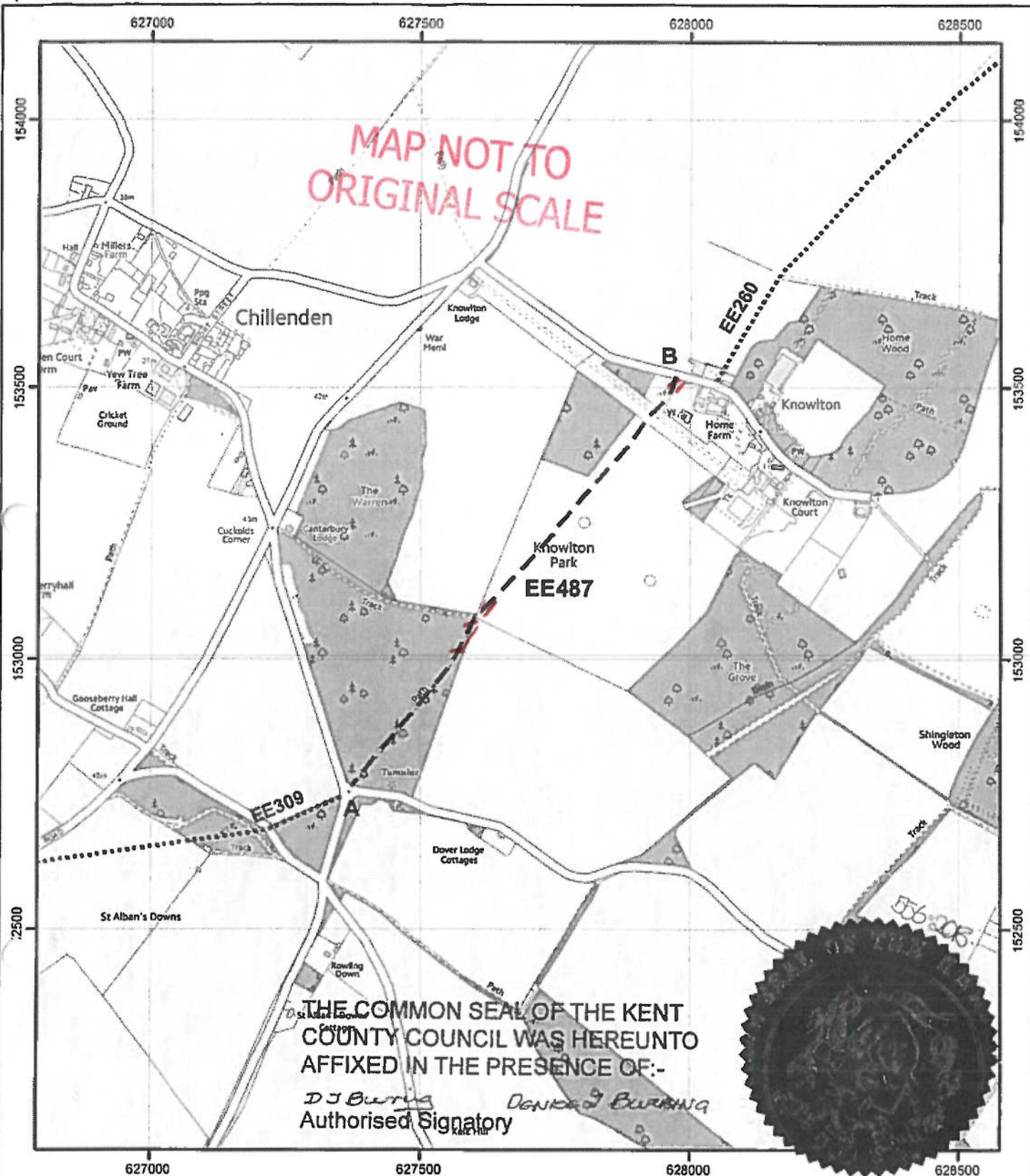

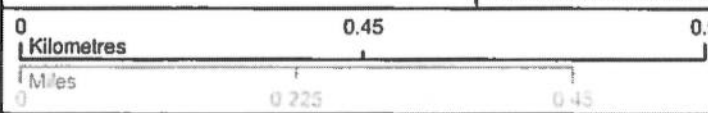
